



## FIXTURES AND FITTINGS

Stainless Steel fixings **MUST** be used for all fixing applications. In cases where Accoya® is affixed to metal other than stainless steel, a barrier must be placed between the Accoya® and the metal - either two coats of standard paint or quality thermal tape. For aluminium, standard commercial powder coating (min 20UM) **MUST** be used.


